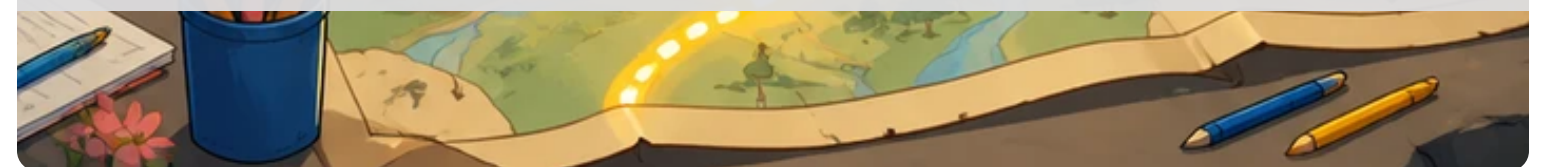




The Blueprint for Learning: An ASSURE Adventure
