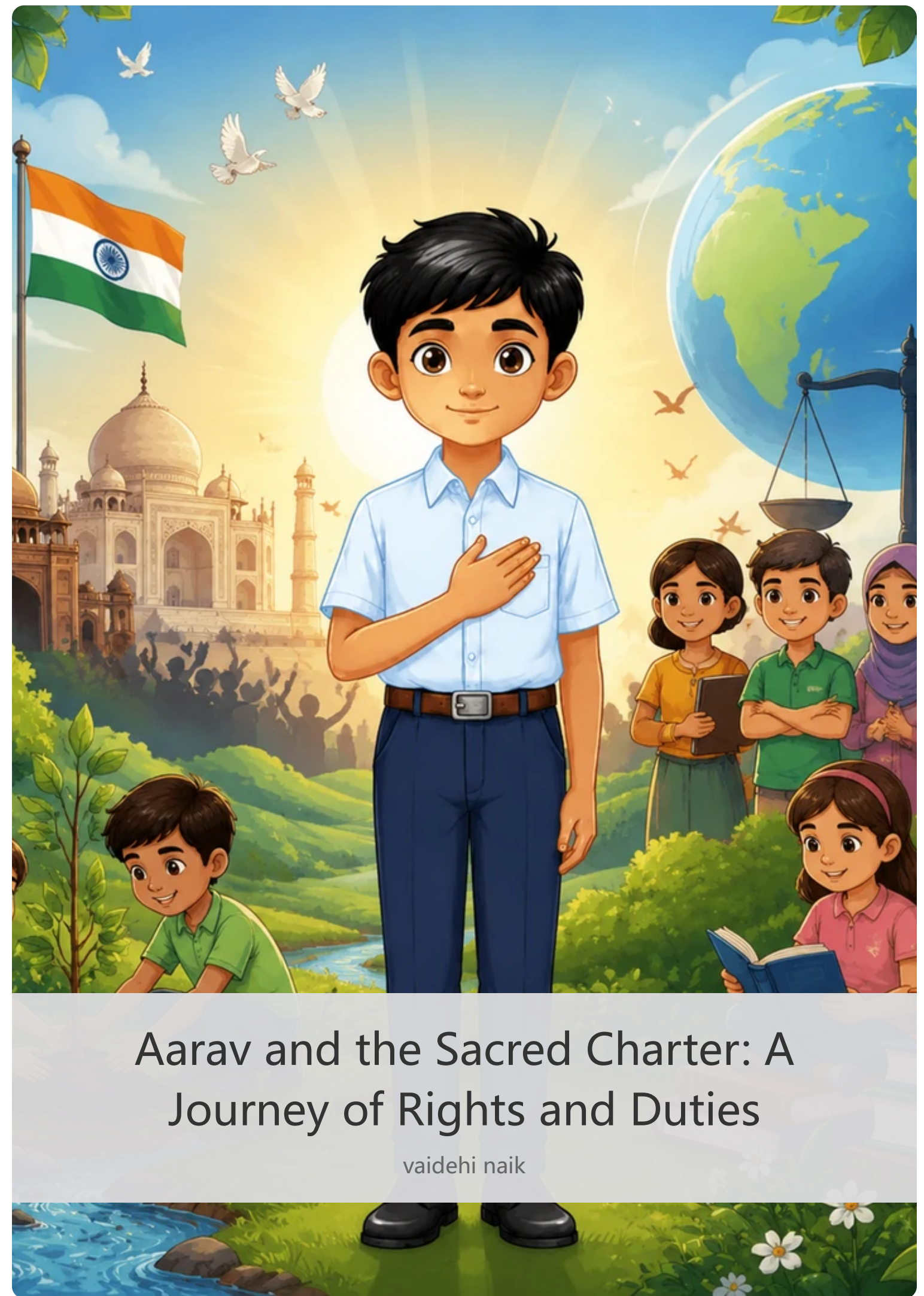




Aarav and the Sacred Charter: A Journey of Rights and Duties

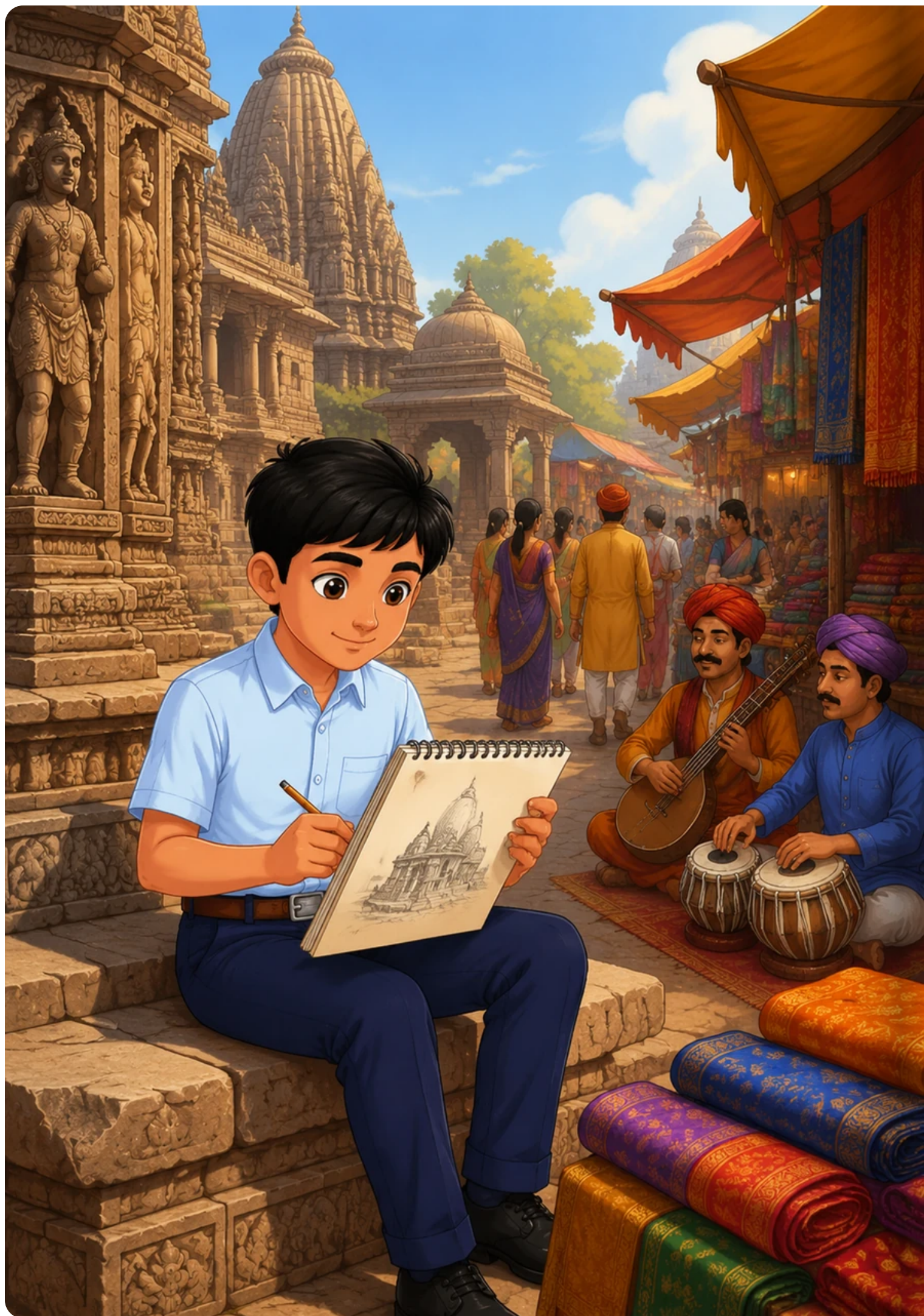
