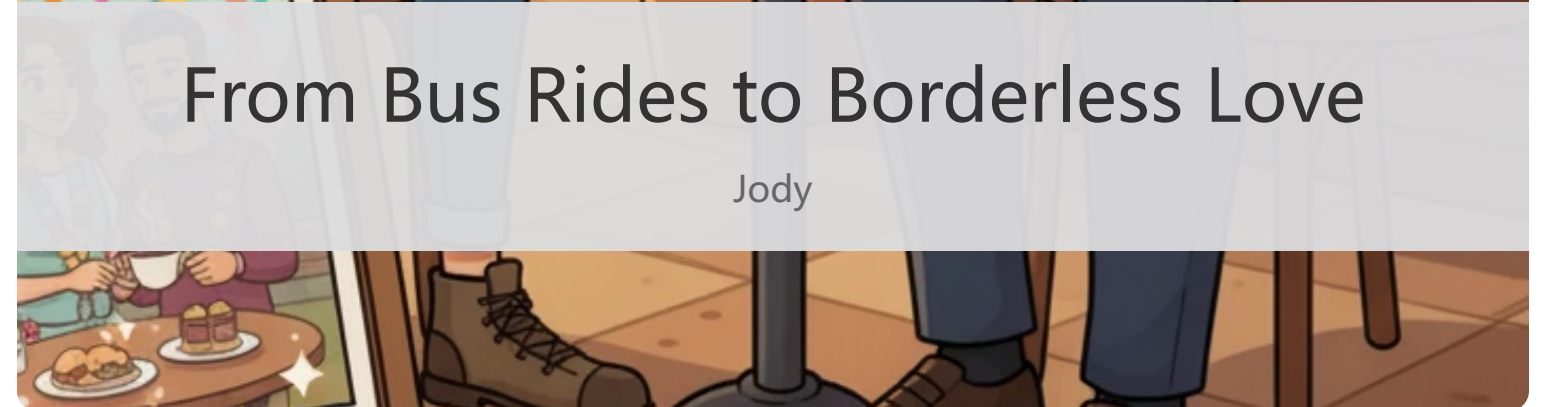




From Bus Rides to Borderless Love
