The doctors were kind. The doctors were gentle. They wanted to listen to JJ's brain.



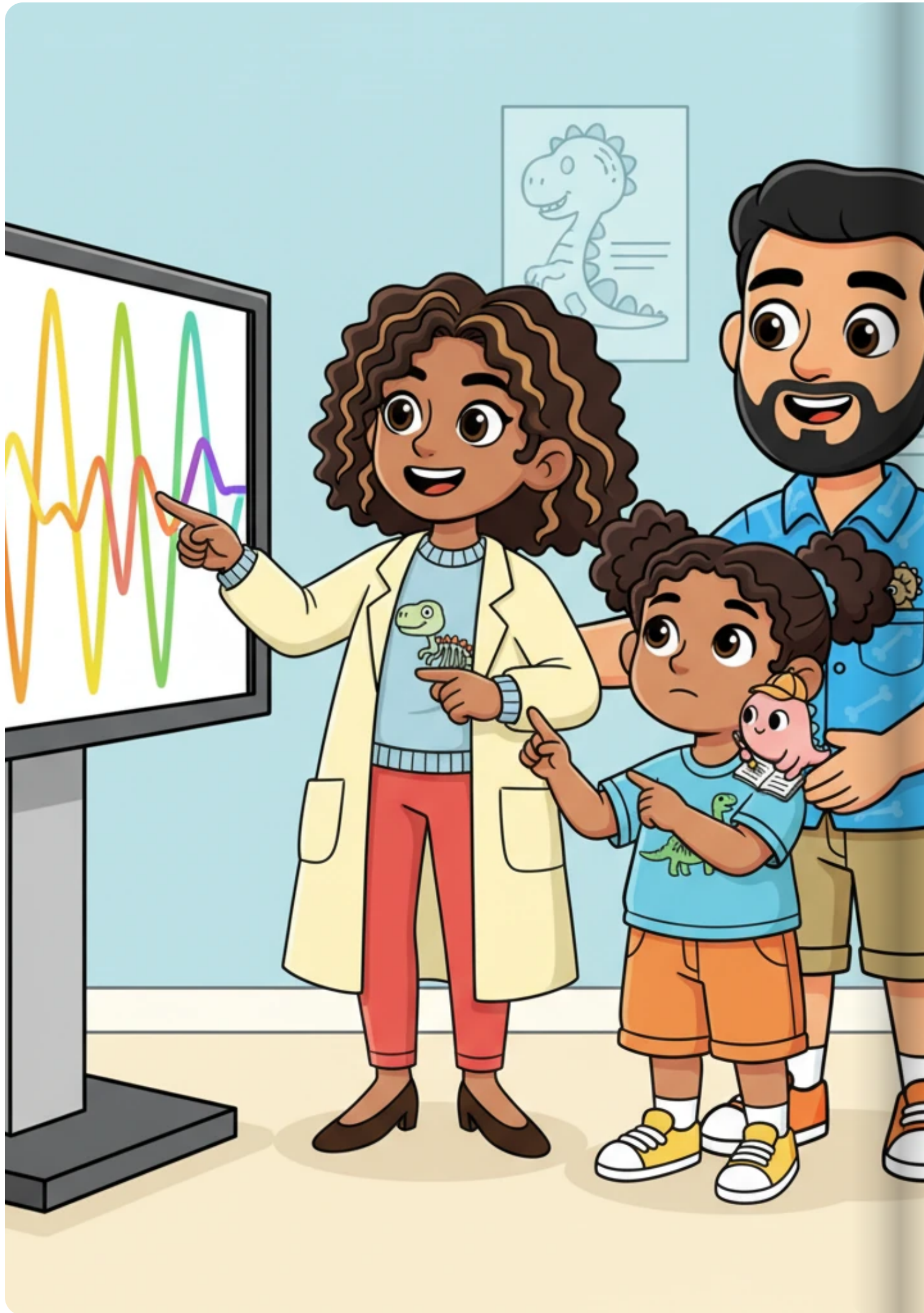
"We're going to do an EEG," said the doctor. EEG? JJ wondered. It was not scary at all, just a little tickly.
