



Lily's Line Art Adventure

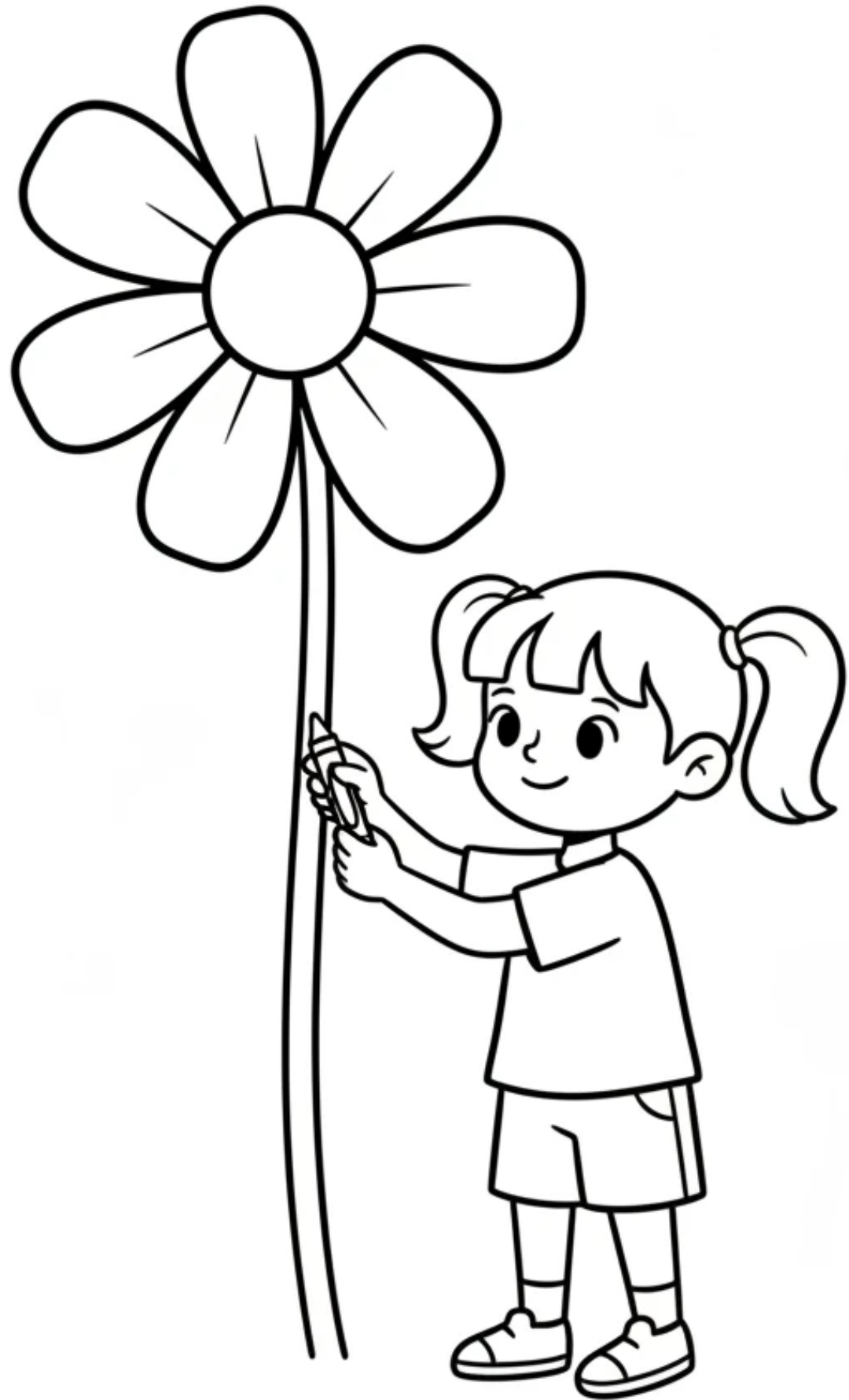

First, Lily drew a big, round sun. It was just an outline, a happy circle with wiggly rays, but she wished it could shine bright yellow.



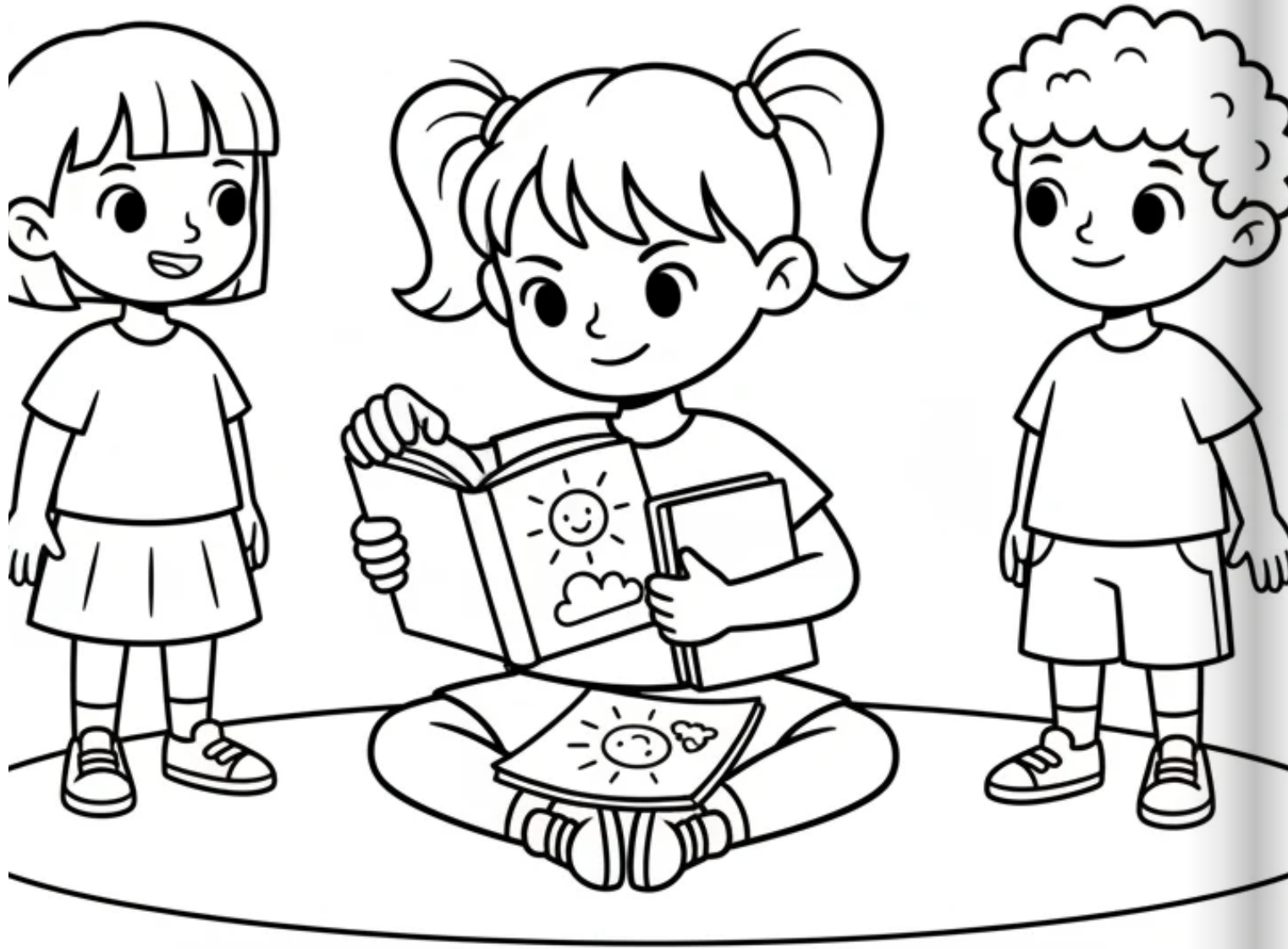
Next, she drew a tall, happy flower. It had a long stem and big, round petals. Lily imagined it bursting with red and green, but for now, it was just a simple black shape.



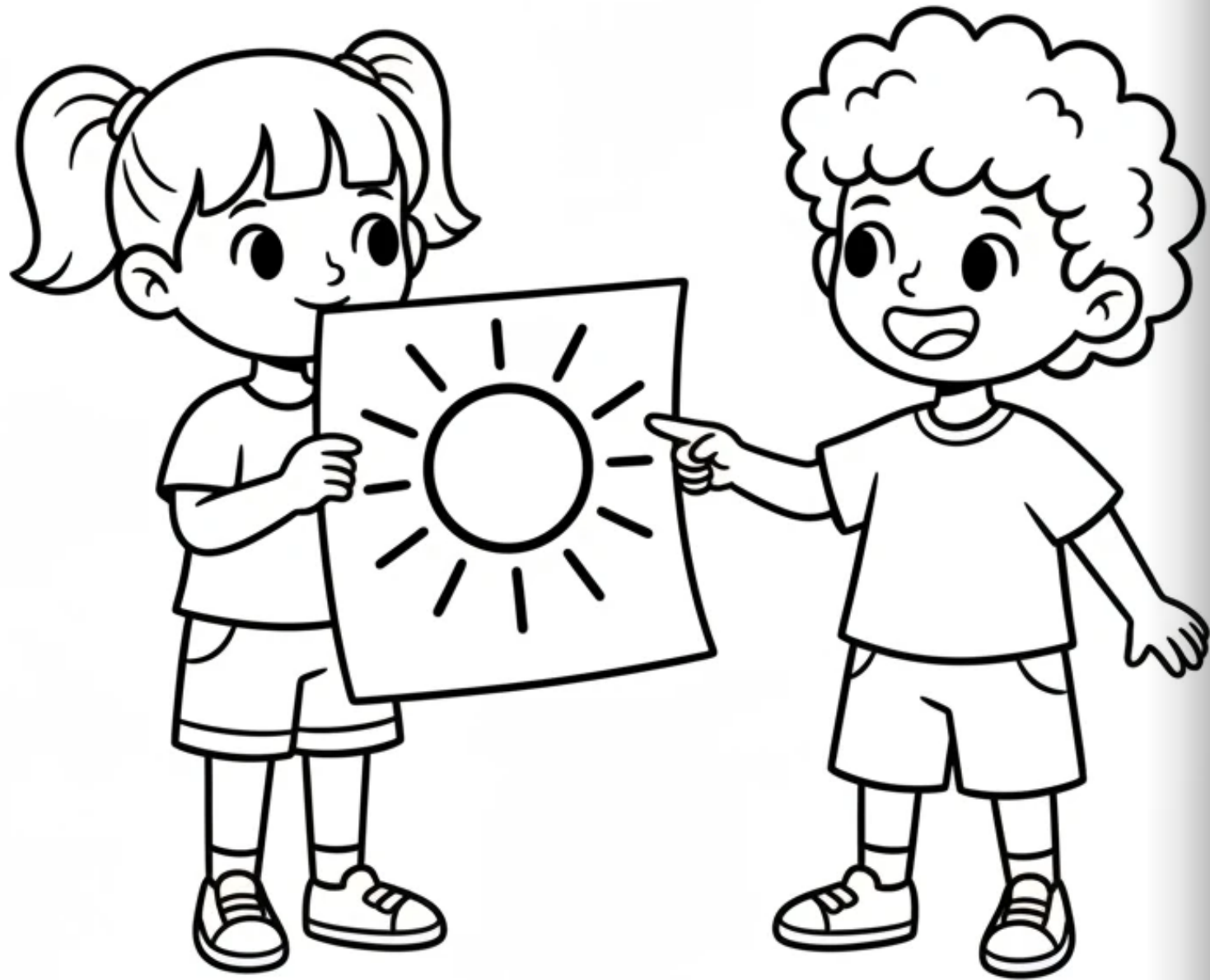

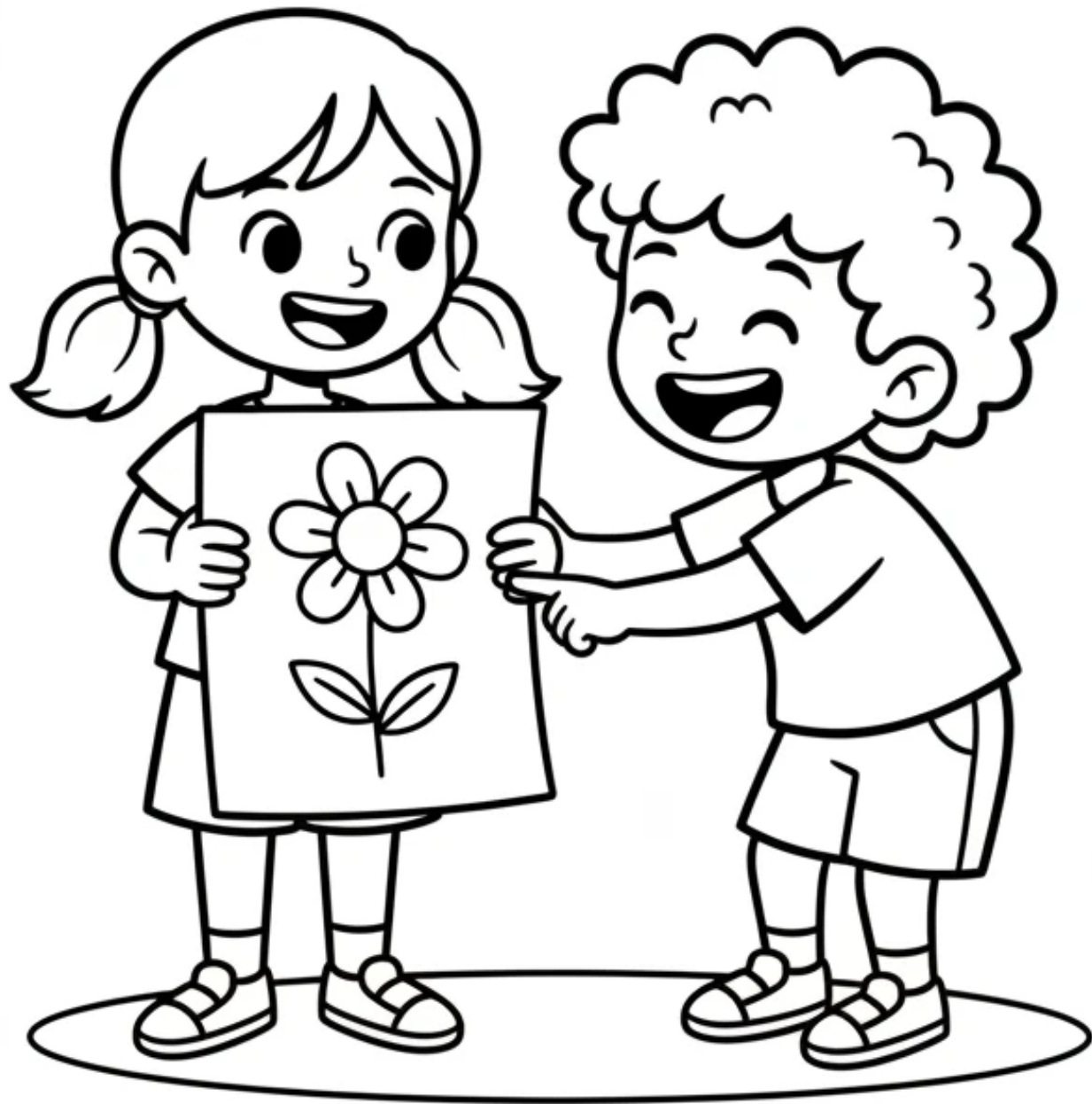
She looked at all her drawings. Even without colors, they were full of life! Each line told a story, waiting for someone to imagine the rest.



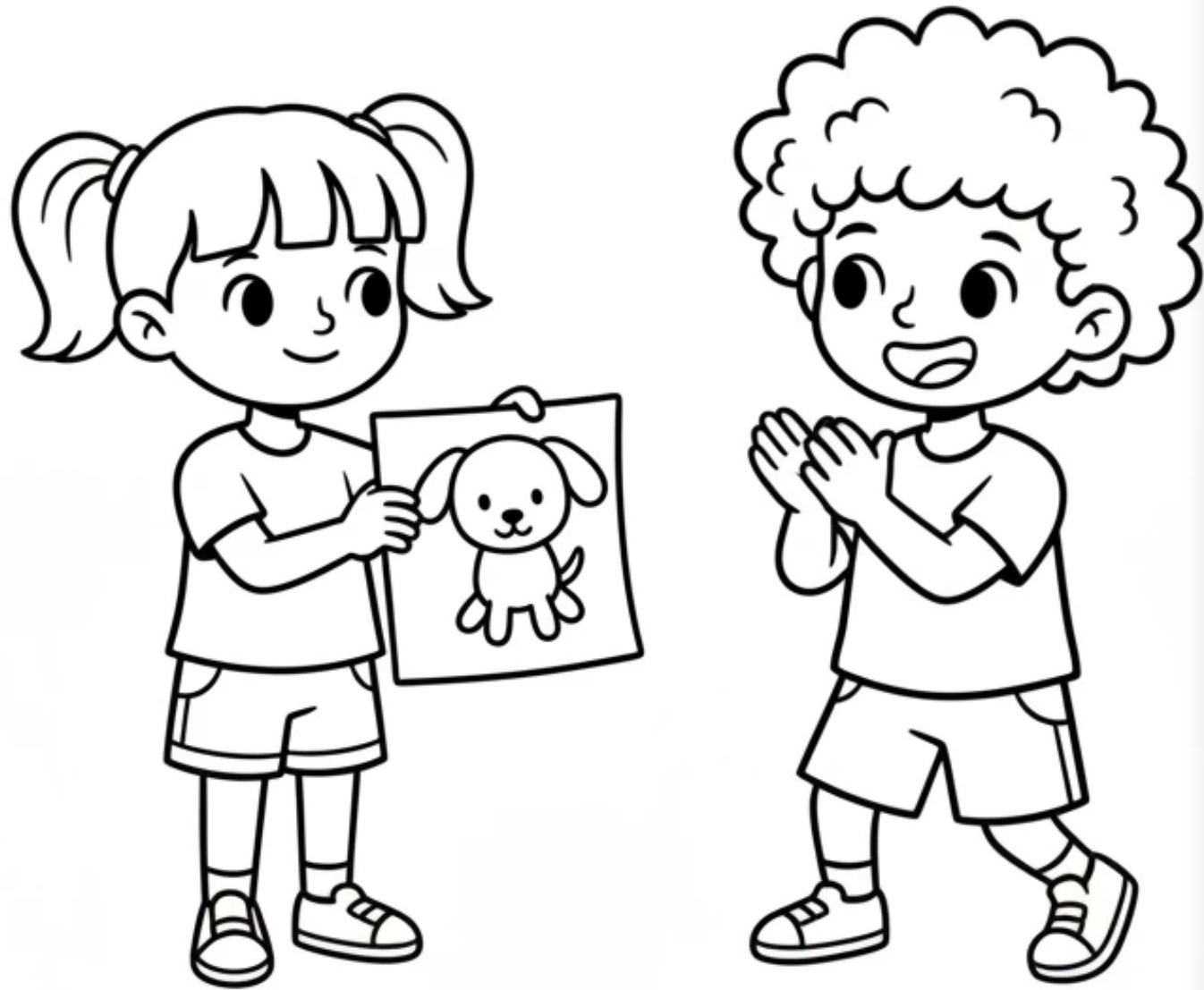
Lily had an idea! She carefully tore out her drawings. She wanted to share her simple line art with her friends, so they could imagine too.
