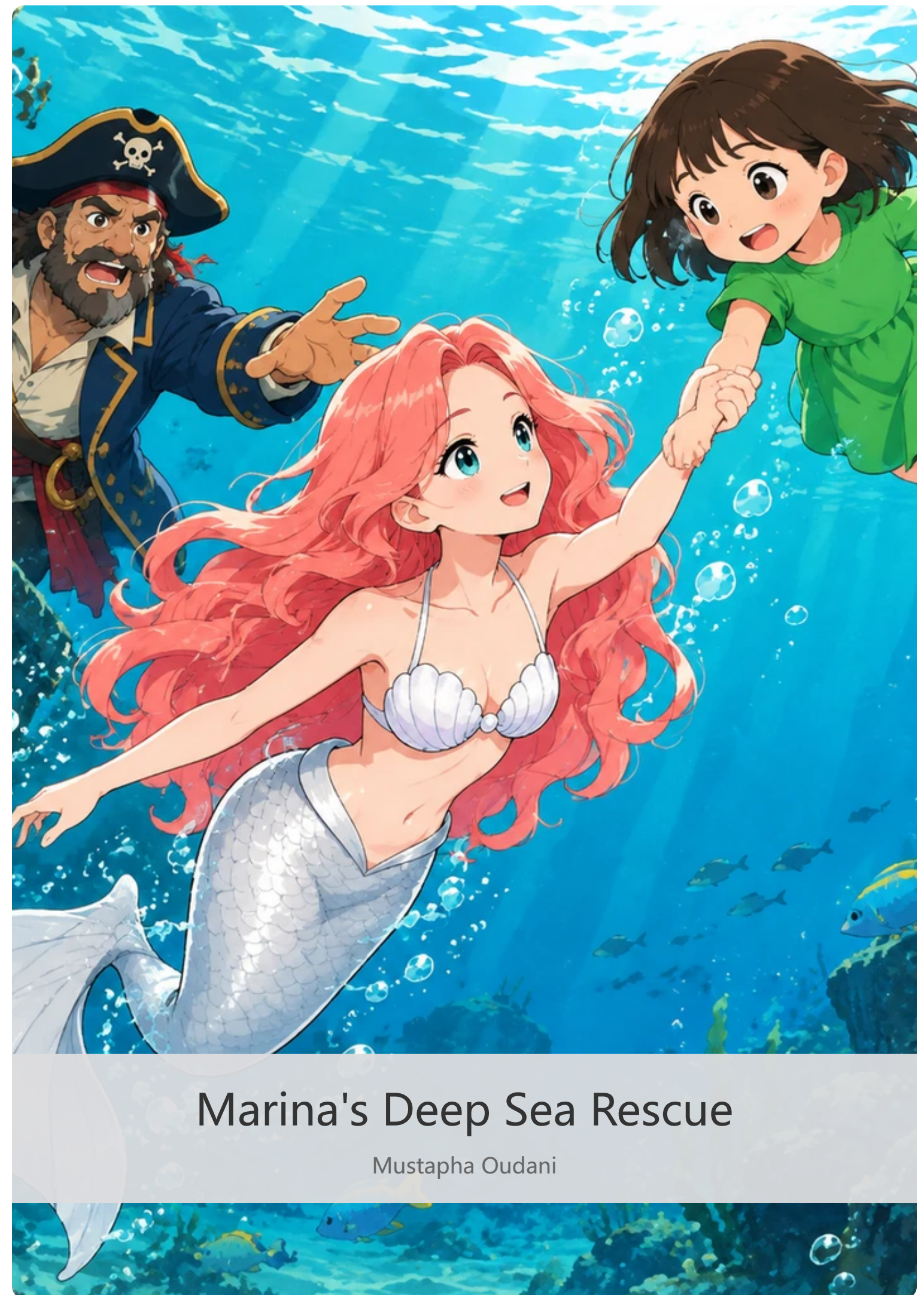




Marina's Deep Sea Rescue

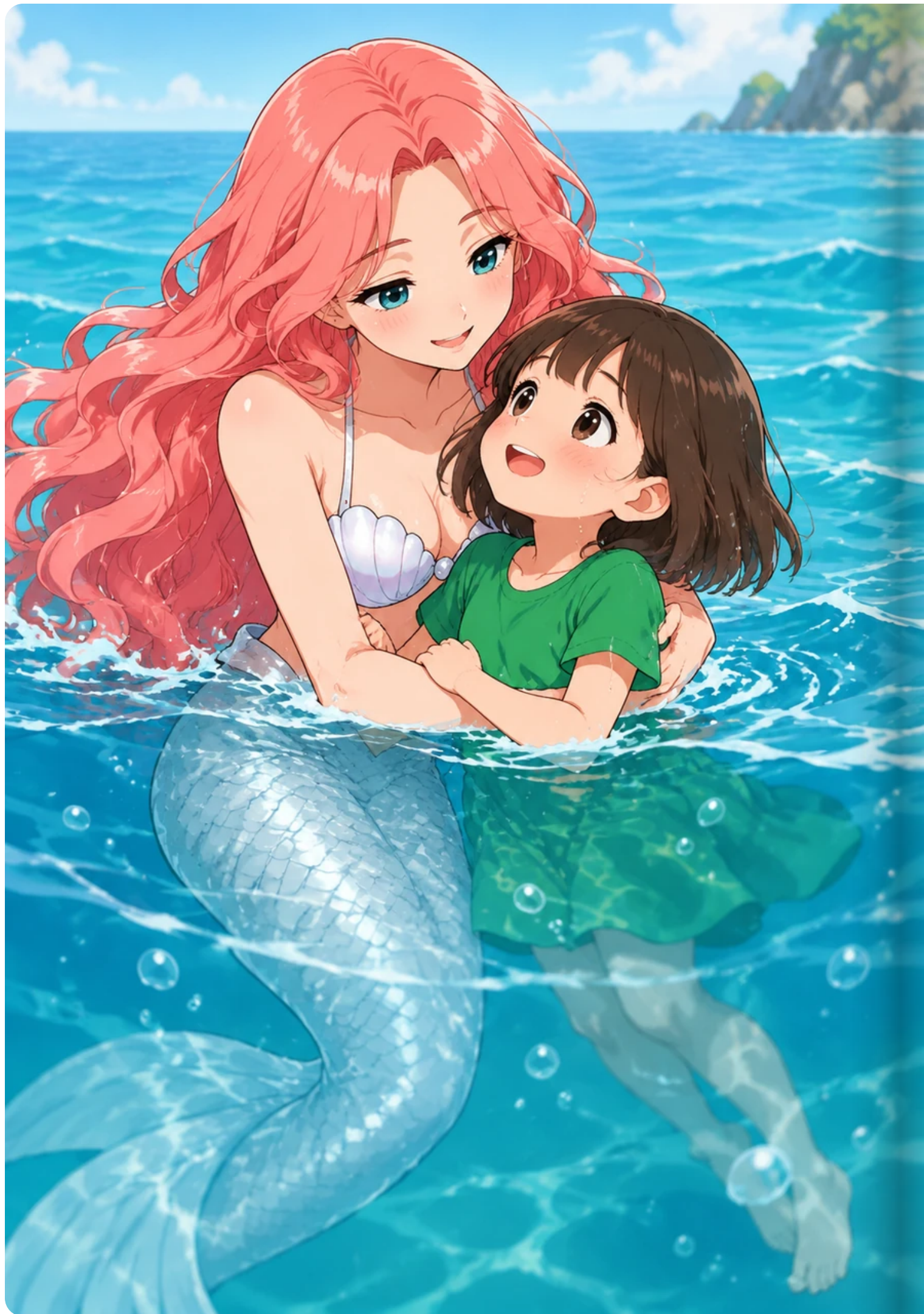
