




# The Adventures of RNA-Ron

Inside the cell, RNA-Ron transformed himself into DNA-Dave, a clever disguise to blend in with the cell's own genetic material.




DNA-Dave hitched a ride on a speedy motor protein, a tiny vehicle that zoomed through the cell's interior.

The motor protein delivered DNA-Dave to the grand Nucleus, the control center of Cellville, where all the important decisions were made.




DNA-Dave snuck inside the Nucleus and started mingling with the cell's own DNA, causing a bit of a ruckus.
