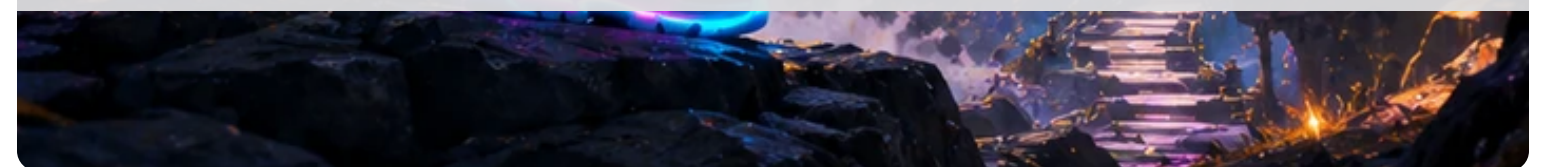




The Guardian of the Whispering Falls

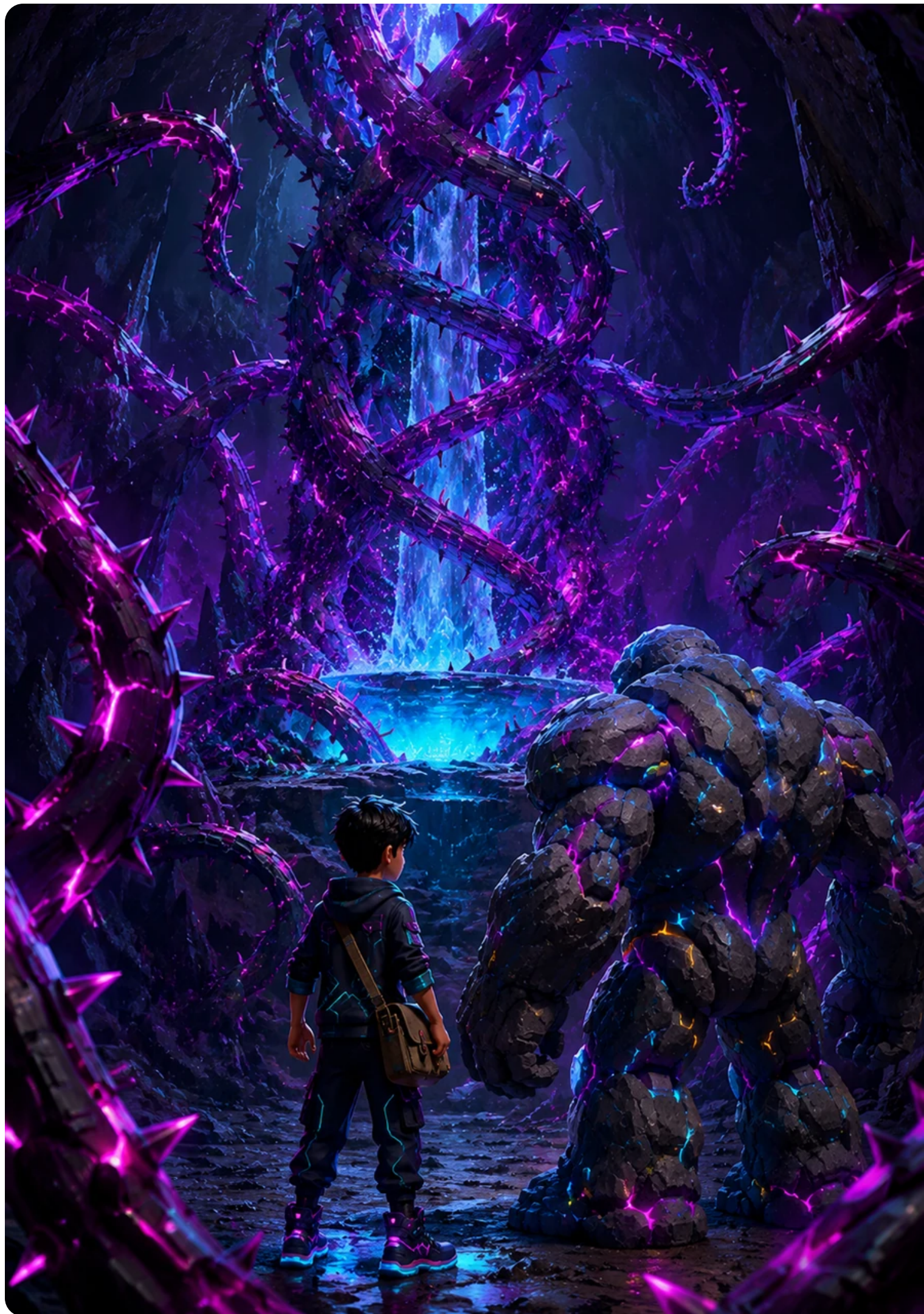
