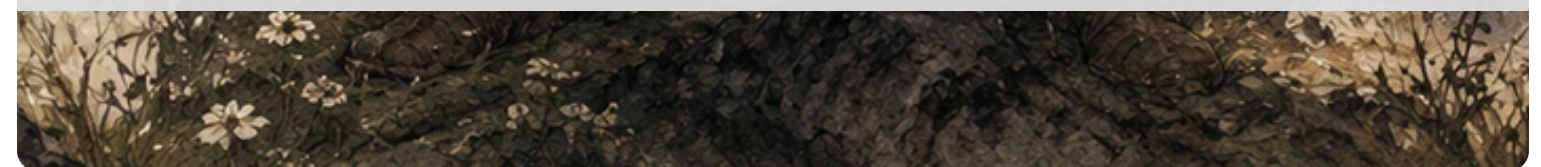




The Knight of the Twin Suns
