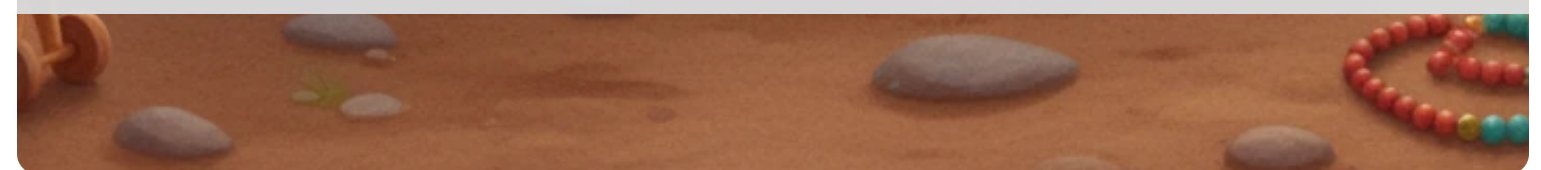




Dharmesh's First Journey: A Village Tale
