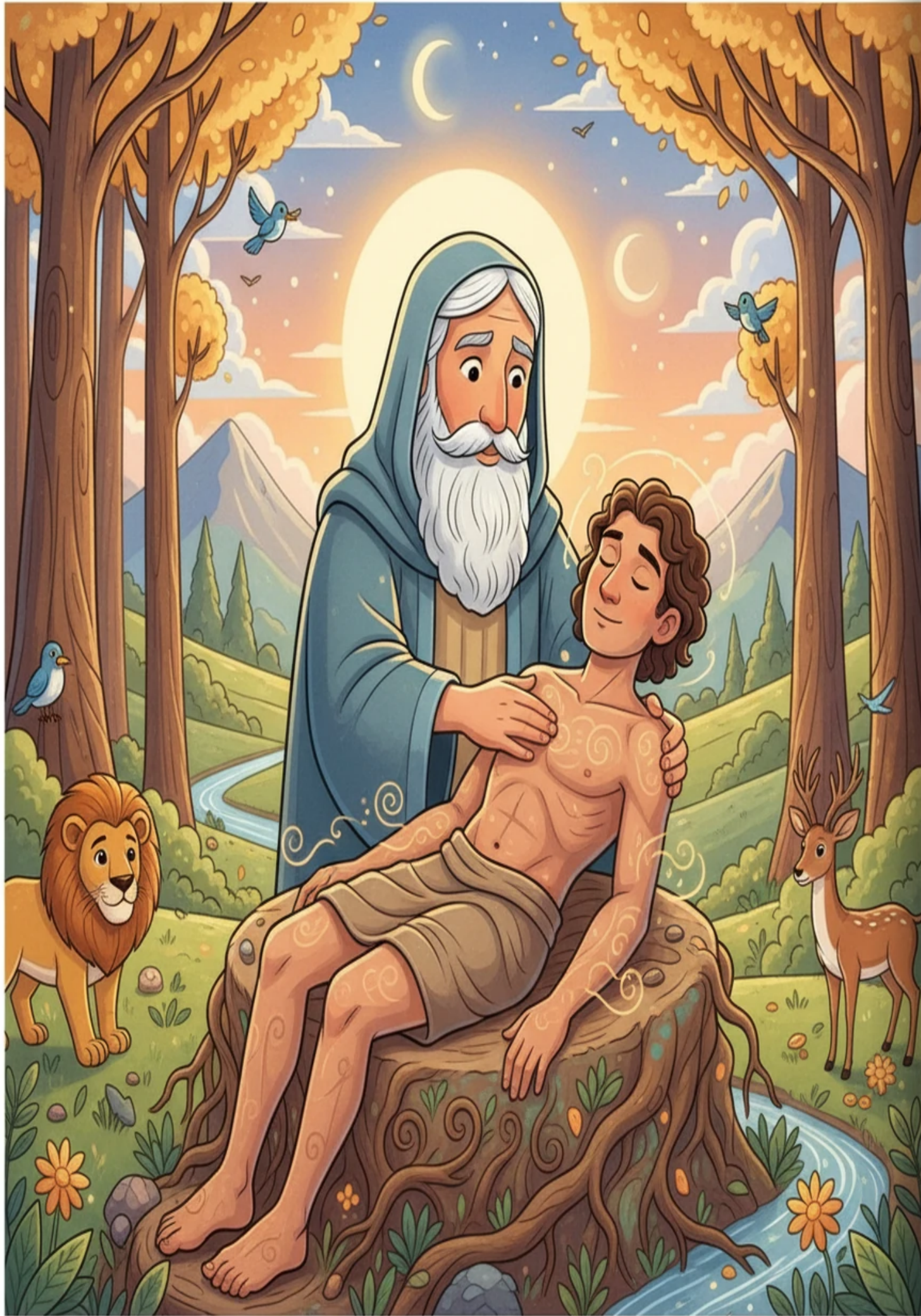




The Creation of Adam

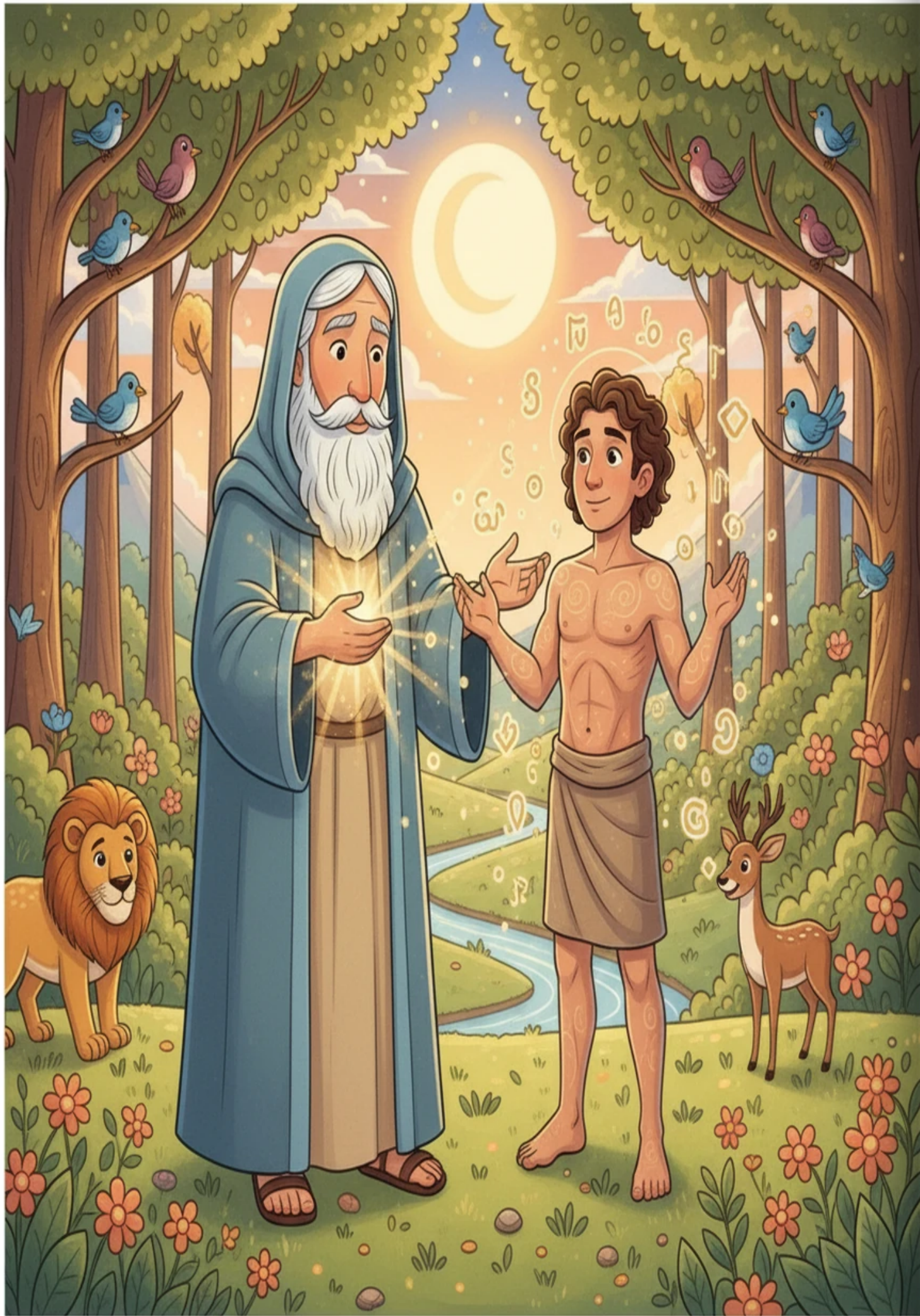
