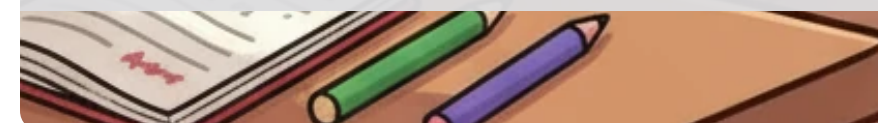




Juan's Journey of Discipline
