

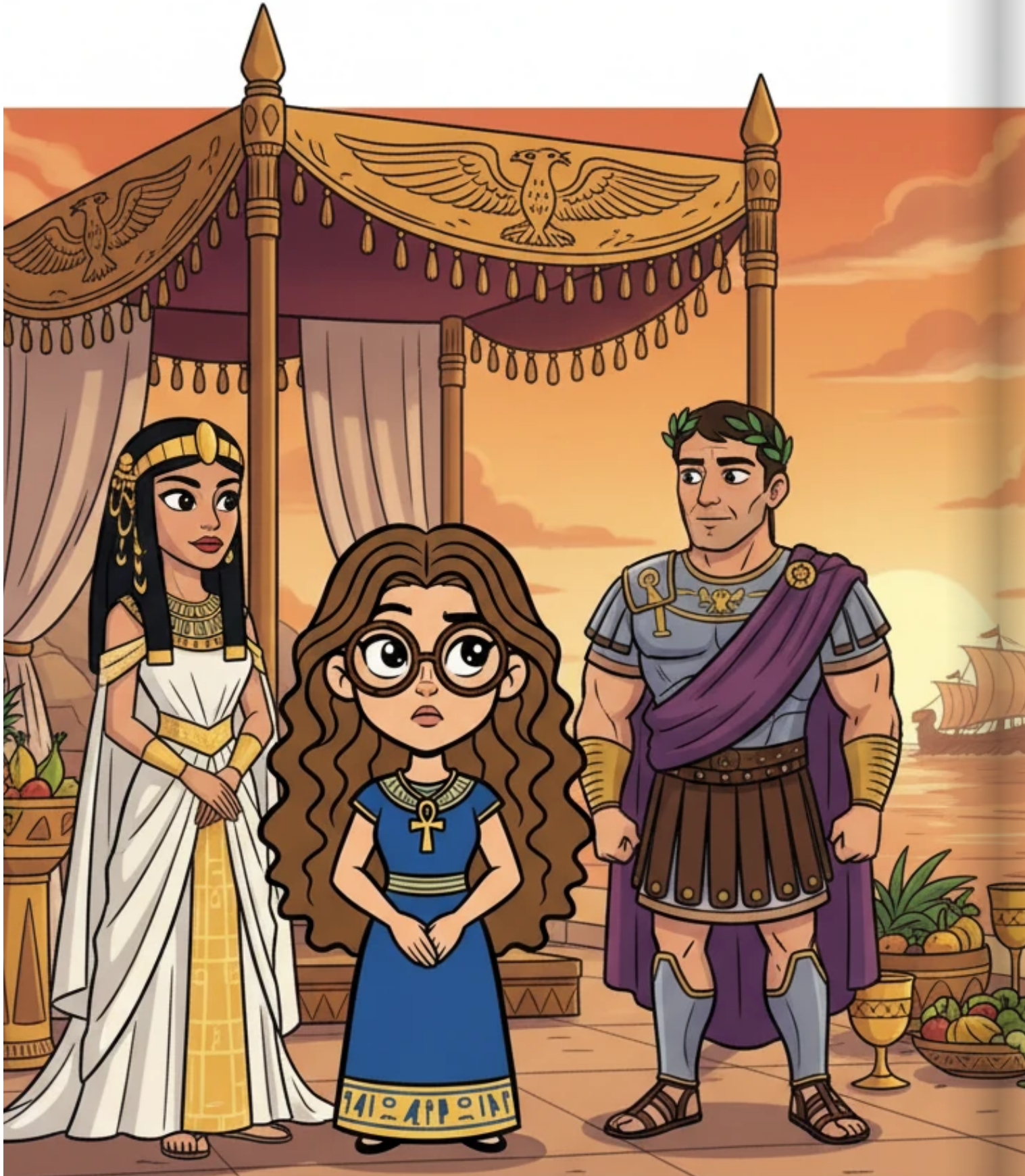


Kayla and the Fall of Alexandria

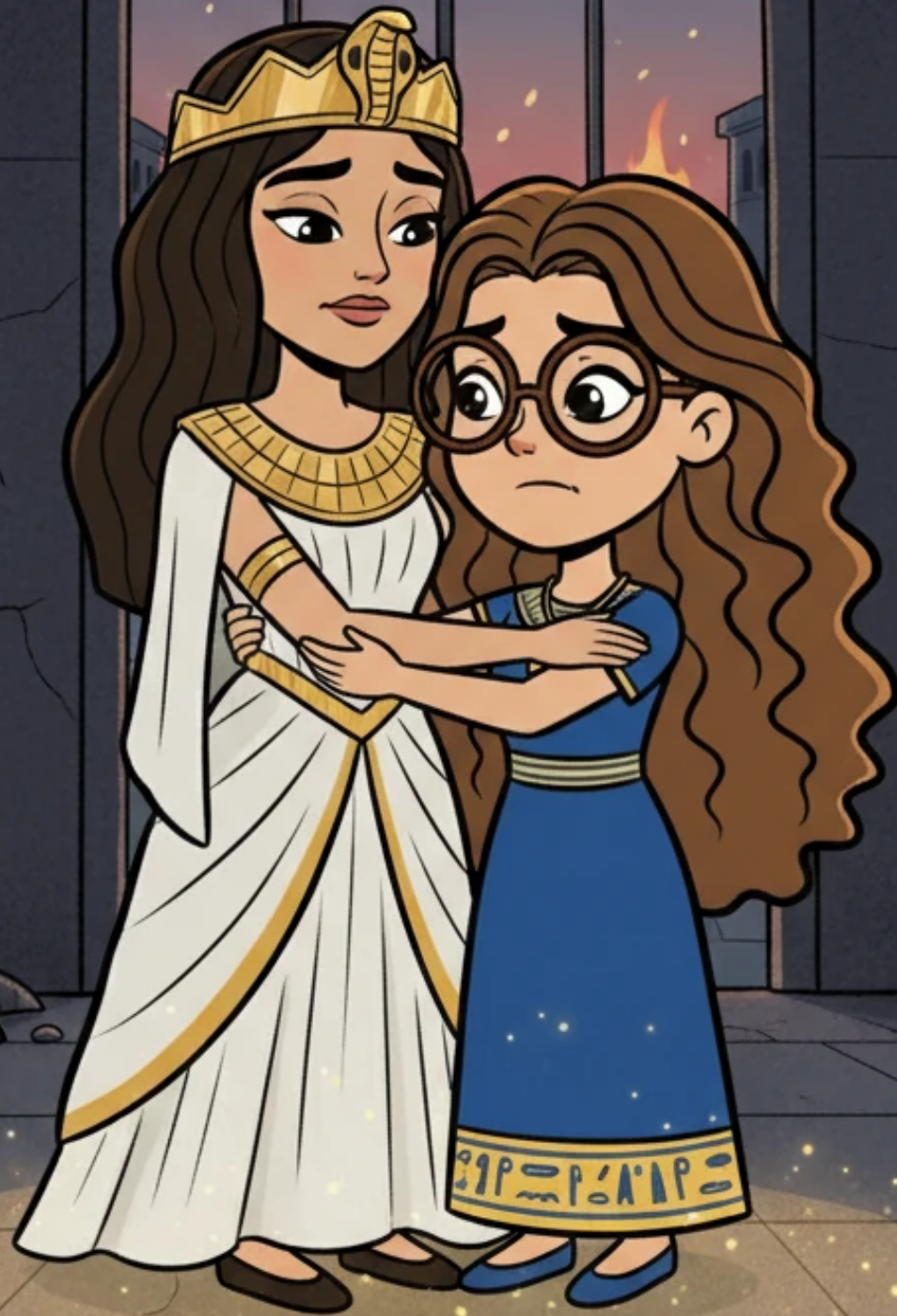
